Fronius’ Weldcom interface is compatible with their TransPuls Synergic and CMT (Cold Metal Transfer) power supplies.

Lincoln Electric’s ArcLink® XT interface is designed for the Power Wave® i400 and R350, and will also work with the PowerWave 455M and 655.
